We are pleased to announce that the academics **Edwin Feulner** and **Gerald O'Driscoll** have joined our International Advisory Council.

**Edwin J. Feulner** was president and founding member of Heritage in 1973. The Heritage Foundation is a think tank with an extensive background that has worked with presidents, vice presidents, senators, congressmen, governors, ambassadors and other public figures of the U.S.A. to implement public policies that defend public enterprise, limited government and individual freedom. He was president of Mont Pelerin Society and the Philadelphia Society, of which he is a distinguished member. He obtained his Ph.D. from the University of Edinburgh in Scotland and his MBA from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.

**Gerald O'Driscoll**, is a senior researcher at the Cato Institute's Center for Monetary and Financial Alternatives. He is internationally recognized for his studies on international monetary subjects and financial topics. He was director of the Center for International Trade and Economics at the Heritage Foundation and senior editor of the Heritage Index of Economic Freedom and the Wall Street Journal. O'Driscoll was also vice president and director of Political Analysis for Citigroup; vice president of the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas and director of the Meltzer Commission in international financial institutions of the US Congress. He is a member of the Mont Pelerin Society and chairs the Association of Private Enterprise Education. Gerald O'Driscoll has a BA in Economics from Fordham and an MA and Ph.D. in Economics from the University of California, Los Angeles.
