José Antonio Aguilar Rivera

We are pleased to announce that the prestigious Mexican political scientist José Antonio Aguilar Rivera has joined our International Advisory Council. Aguilar Rivera is a writer, researcher and academic. Graduated in International Relations from El Colegio de México. Ph.D. in Political Sciences, University of Chicago. Professor and researcher at the Division of Political Studies of the Center of Economic Investigation and Research (Cide). He has written books and articles on political theory and the constitutional and political history of Mexico and Latin America. He has also published work on the intellectuals and the debate around multiculturalism in Mexico and the United States. He was awarded the 1995 Carlos Pereyra Prize for Political Essay.
