The seminar provides a platform for participants to reflect and exchange views on policies, examine and discuss primary challenges they face in promoting markets and entrepreneurship, share experiences on the implementation of those policies, how to engage with stakeholders in order to improve them with the main goal being to opening markets and promoting entrepreneurship. Participants will have the opportunity to develop and propose liberal policy recommendations.

On Wednesday, June 1, at 1:00 pm Dr. Pablo Guido will present the book: “Álvaro Alsogaray. Sus ideas y acción legislativa” (Alvaro Alsogaray. His ideas and legislative action), co-authored with Dr. Ricardo Rojas, *fellow* of the Friedman Hayek Center.

The book will address the political career of Álvaro Alsogaray and his struggle for the dissemination of liberal ideas in the second half of the 20th Century in Argentina, investigating his party trajectory and the doctrinal sources on which he based it, as also his actions as a Member of the Congress.

On Thursday, May 26 at 12.30 pm Dr. Edgardo Zablotsky, Executive Director of the Friedman Hayek Center, will give a presentation on “Una mejor educación es posible” (A better education is possible).

“Better education offers a hope of narrowing the gap between the most and least skilled workers, of defending against the prospect of a society divided between the rich and the poor, of a class society in which an educated elite supports a permanent class of unemployed” Milton Friedman, 1998.

For many years now, education in Argentina has been my obsession. The quote explains why. I would venture to add that a better education offers the hope of having a country less similar to today’s Argentina. That is why I will dedicate this talk to propose to you how, in my opinion, it is possible to achieve it.
