

#### NEXT SEMINAR OF THE CYCLE FOR THE STUDY OF A FREE SOCIETY

On Wednesday, July 6 at 5 pm Dr. Ayelén Sánchez, *fellow* of the Friedman Hayek Center, will give the presentation: "Ser libre" se dice de muchas maneras: Algunas herramientas filosóficas para pensar de qué hablamos cuando hablamos de libertad" ("Being free" is said in many ways: Some philosophical tools to think about what we are talking about when we talk of freedom).

During this talk some of the most important meanings that the concept of human freedom acquires will be analyzed. The presentation will try to show that, even though there exists a diversity of ways of conceiving freedom, that does not mean that they are all equally valid. Especially, it will propose a reflection with regard to the intimate connections that exist between the possibility of being free and our constitution as rational beings.

# NEXT SEMINAR OF THE HISTORY AND FREEDOM CYCLE – PRESENTATION OF THE BOOK THE POOR PAY

On Wednesday July 6 at 1 p.m. Dr. Juan Sebastián Landoni, *fellow* of the Center, will present the book "Pagan los pobres" (The poor pay), written jointly with Luciano Villegas.

The poor pay does not reflect on the poverty of the ascetic, but thinks of the poverty of those who are trapped by a cultural, social, economic and political environment that prevents them from getting out of a situation they do not want. Public policy mistakes have negative consequences for many individuals and groups. But the burden of those mistakes ultimately falls on the poor, both old and new ones. Nevertheless, this is not a book against public policy but about the unintended consequences of public policies with good intentions; those that

	Dr. Daniel Lema, <i>fellow</i> of the Center will give the seminar "La economía política del 'valor agregado' en el agro" (The political economy of 'added value' in agriculture"). The concept of Added Value (AV) and its use as economic indicator for evaluating activities in the agroindustrial chain. Through a theoretical analysis and a series of examples it is shown that the concept AV cannot be used as a guide for private economic decision making or for the design of public policies. The cycle is organized and coordinated by Dr. Marcos Gallacher, who is also a <i>fellow</i> at the Center.
