#### **DR. LORIS ZANATTA – INCORPORATION AS MEMBER OF THE INTERNATIONAL ADVISORY COUNCIL**

We are very pleased with the recent incorporation of Dr. Loris Zanatta to the International Advisory Council of the Friedman Hayek Center for the Study of a Free Society.

Loris Zanatta is professor of Latin American History at the University of Bologna, Italy. He has published books and articles in various journals in Europe and Latin America. Among his works, the following stand out: *Del Estado liberal a la nación católica. 1930-1943 (From the Liberal State to the Catholic Nation. 1930-1943)* (Buenos Aires, 1996), *Perón y el mito de la nación católica. 1943-1946 (Peron and the myth of the Catholic nation. 1943-1946)* (Buenos Aires, 1999), *Historia de la Iglesia argentina (History of the Argentine church)* (with R. Di Stefano, Buenos Aires, 2000), *Breve historia del peronismo clásico (Brief history of classic Peronism)* (Buenos Aires, 2009), *Eva Perón. Una biografía política (Eva Peron. A political biography)* (Buenos Aires, 2011) and *Historia de América Latina. De la colonia al siglo XXI (History of Latin America. From the colony to the 21st century)* (Buenos Aires, 2012).
