Her presentation is entitled: “Libertad, Liberalismo y Democracia en América Latina: una difícil combinación” (Freedom, Liberalism and Democracy in Latin America: a difficult combination), addressing the main points of her homonymous monography, which won the essay contest “Caminos de la Libertad” (Paths of Freedom) 2022.

COURSE ON THE ESSENTIALS OF LIBERALISM

Yesterday, Tuesday, August 22, the online course “Lo esencial del liberalismo” (The essentials of liberalism) began with an inaugural class given by Dr. Enrique Aguilar, *fellow* of the Center. The course, whose faculty is also composed entirely *fellows* of the Friedman Hayek Center, seeks to bring the main foundations of liberal thought closer to a mass audience.

Yesterday’s session was attended by more than 750 participants, connected through Zoom and UCEMA’s YouTube channel, broadcasting the session simultaneously. There were more than 100 interventions from the audience and a total registration of around 2500 people, mainly located in Latin America, USA and Europe.

The course concludes on December 12 with a closing keynote lecture by Dr. Alberto Benegas Lynch (h.), *fellow* of the Center. With this new initiative, the Friedman Hayek Center reaffirms its mission and purpose in bringing liberal theory and praxis closer to large audiences, made up both by specialists as by general public.
